

Motor Vehicle Violation DEMERITPOINTS

Some common violations and their points are listed below.

- 1 point** Failure to obtain a NH driver's license

- 2 points** Unregistered vehicle
Operation without motorcycle license

- 3 points** Disobeying required traffic control device
Failure to obey stop and yield signs
Speeding—less than 25 MPH above posted limit
Failure to signal turn
Following too closely

- 4 points** Driving without license contrary to RSA 263: 1
Speeding - 25 MPH or more above posted limit
Improper passing
Yellow line violation

- 6 points** Driving after revocation or suspension
Disobeying a police officer
Reckless driving
Racing
Driving under the influence of drugs/liquor

How Demerit Points = Suspension

Driver **under 18** yearsold:

Point Total

Suspension

6 points in one calendar year
12 points in two calendar years
18 points in three calendar years

- up to 3 months
- up to 6 months
- upto 1 year

Driver 18 - 20 years old:

Point Total

Suspension

9 points in one calendar year
15 points in two calendar years
21 points in three calendar years

- up to 3 months
- up to 6 months
- upto 1 year

Driver 21 years old and older

Point Total

Suspension

12 points in one calendar year
18 points in two calendar years
24 points in three calendar years

= up to 3 months
= up to 6 months
- upto 1 year

REDUCE 3 POINTS from your point assessment total by taking a 6-hour defensive driving/attitude course.*

Courses available every Saturday, locations statewide.

* Per NH law, points remain on driving record but do not count toward license suspension.
